Each tasting is unique plus we have three special events. The September event kicks off our wine tasting season at a different location each year.

Our Holiday Extravaganza is in December and features a variety of champagnes and wines.

The Anniversary Dinner ends our season in May. The chefs at Hayden Lake Country Club show their talents with special hors d'oeuvres and an elegant five course dinner accompanied by high-end wines paired to each course. NIES breaks for the summer.

The NIES annual membership dues are \$25 per person, due in September of each year and are not prorated for joining mid-year. All members and guests must be 21 and older.
